How do we engage the issue of race during a time when the subject is so rife with tension?

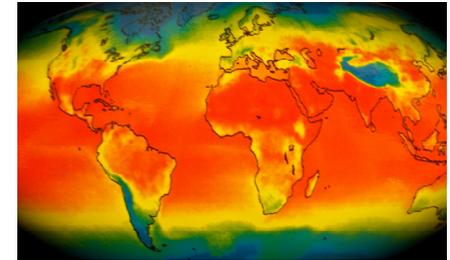


CLIMATE CHANGE, NU? A CLIMATE CHANGE UPDATE
